As per our Homework Policy your child should spend approximately 15 mins at homework + 10 mins Reading time (library books/ CAPER etc.).

P.E.

Please ensure your child wears the school tracksuit, yellow polo shirt and suitable footwear on PE day. Full uniform must be worn on all other days. **PE will be on Mondays for Term 1**.

Procedure for withdrawal/absence

A child to be collected during the school day is collected at the office through our school secretary. In case of absence from school, parents must fill the 'Explanation of Absence' note which, can be found at the back of the child's school journal and send it to the class teacher. We are obliged to report any child who is absent for more than twenty days to the Education Welfare Officer.

Golden Time: As a reward for hard work/good behaviour your child may occasionally be invited to bring a toy/game to school. Electronic toys (Gameboys, tablets etc) are not allowed but board games, jigsaws, lego and games that

promote social interaction would be welcome. Please ensure that your child does not bring anything of sentimental or monetary value to school.
